For the past five years, the EHL has finished as the leader in the Direct-To-College Advancement at the NCAA Division II and III levels. This past season alone, the EHL accounted for nearly 1 in every 5 freshmen on Division II and III rosters.

To go along with the NCAA Commitments, the EHL has also helped over 80 players work their way up the USA Hockey Ladder of Development to the North American Hockey League (NAHL) and the United States Hockey League (USHL). This area of advancement is also not limited to just players, as the EHL has seen several coaches make the jump up the ladder as well.

From 2006-2009 he was an assistant coach and sports management faculty member at SUNY Fredonia in the NCAA. In 2004-2006 Heffernan led the Cleveland Barons U18AAA club to 2 consecutive state championships. Heffernan started his coaching career as a graduate assistant at Mercyhurst NCAA Division 1 in 2002.
