

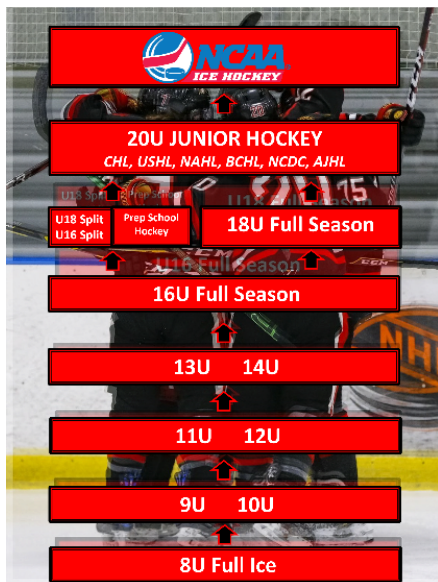


# U16 FULL SEASON (2009,2010)

## **16U Head Coach Yvon “Ike” Corriveau**

Coach Ike Corriveau, a seasoned veteran with two decades of professional hockey under his belt, continues to steer the Premier Hockey Group & CT Chiefs with a wealth of expertise garnered over 1200 games from 1985 to 2005.

A first-round pick drafted by the Washington Capitals in 1985, Ike's NHL journey saw him grace the ice in 360 regular-season games for the Capitals, Hartford Whalers, and San Jose Sharks. His playoff prowess shone in 50 NHL postseason matchups. Not stopping there, Ike's grind extended to the IHL and AHL, where he notched 430 regular-season games and clinched championships with both the Calder Cup and Turner Cup teams.

Venturing across the pond, Ike carved his path in Europe, tallying over 400 games in the DEL (Deutsche Elite League) with Berlin, Germany.

In his earlier years, Ike showcased his talent as a Major Junior A player with the Toronto Marlies (OHL) and proudly donned the Team Canada jersey, leaving his mark in the World Junior Championship in Piestany, Czechoslovakia, alongside hockey luminaries like Brendan Shanahan, Pierre Turgeon, Steve Chiasson, Theron Fluery, and Jimmy Waite.

Since hanging up his skates in 2005, Ike seamlessly transitioned into the realm of coaching youth hockey, with remarkable success. Notably, he led the 1997 team to their inaugural appearance at the USA Hockey National Championships in 2010. Further, Ike's stewardship saw the U18 Mid Fairfield Chiefs secure back-to-back berths at the USA Hockey National Championships, clinching the U18 National Championship in 2017. His coaching prowess was evident as he guided the 2006 birth year to clinch the 15U AYHL Championship in the 2021-2022 season.

In his role as Hockey Director, Ike's influence has been pivotal in shepherding numerous CT Chiefs players to successful transitions into Prep, Junior, and College hockey arenas.
